**GENERAL ORDER 08-02**

On November 18, 2008, the Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules requested approval of Interim Rule 1007-I, entitled "Lists, Schedules, Statements, and Other Documents; Time Limits; Expiration of Temporary Means Testing Exclusion." Interim Rule 1007-I amends Official Form 22A, Statement of Current Monthly Income and Means Test Calculation, to implement the *National Guard and Reservist Debt Relief Act of 2008*, Pub. L. 110-438. The Act excludes certain members of the National Guard and Reserves from means testing in Chapter 7 cases that are commenced in the three-year period beginning on December 19, 2008.

Acting on behalf of the Judicial Conference, the Executive Committee has approved the revision of Official Form 22A, which includes a new Part 1C where qualifying debtors can invoke the temporary exclusion from the means test.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** that Interim Rule 1007-I of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure be and hereby is ADOPTED.
